I oppose 2200 because most small town local correction facilities do not have more than one of possibly two officers on duty. This would place a big burden to contact anyone within the time limits. Also Rep. Wilde did not define Pretrial.

I feel if the State wants this degree of care for detainees, it should pay for it. This bill does not reimburse the small towns for the cost of providing this extra service.

Our correction facilities askes questions of the detainee to determine what problems they may have, if they can comprehend the questions.

Please vote this bill down, or amend it to large cities only.
