I was fortunate to find and contact this agency, I very often felt alone and worried endlessly about issues I had to confront by myself in dealing with a long term care agency and having to navigate and understand how state agencies worked. Since my contact with Residential Facilities Ombudsman all the difficulties I faced in the past have been resolved by the members of this agency. I can honestly say, the people of this agency have never failed to address concerns, helped to answer questions, or to immediately response and take action to help. This agency has been professional, knowledgeable, courteous and has approached all concerns with great attention to detail and follow up on all cases to make certain the issues were addressed appropriately with an acceptable outcome. Again, my thanks for the opportunity to comment on the importance of the Residential Ombudsman Program. Please fund this much needed agency. It is so very valuable and needed for the protection of the lives of the disabled and the family members of the disabled, who love and worry about them.
