The people who choose still to go out to enjoy towed wake sports will be crowded into small areas or forced to drive hours to find bodies of water that are open to the public. Before a decision like this is made, I would hope that a thorough study of the Willamette would be conducted to prove that wake boats are causing damage to the ecosystem.
