However, when making important decisions that will surely, have an impact on the lives of our citizens and local communities, you must do so with caution and with undeniable scientific backing. Not solely on the emotions of a small group with their own benefit in mind.

There has been no real, unbiased scientific evidence leading to the accusations of damages caused by certain wake boats. On average, the Willamette river flows over 32,000 cubic feet per second, making the water displacement of boats sound minuscule.
