As the mother of a teenager, I am writing to urge you to support HB 2510.

An estimated 54% of gun owners do not lock up all of their firearms and as a result, every year nearly 350 American children under the age of 18 gain access to a gun and unintentionally shoot themselves or others. Youth suicide is a growing problem in Oregon, and access to a firearm greatly increases the chance of a fatal outcome in the event of a suicide attempt. Furthermore, the lack of a safe storage law contributed to more than 22,000 firearms being stolen in Oregon over the past 10 years. HB 2510 would help prevent gun trafficking.
