Dear members of the House Committee on Health Care:

I strongly oppose HB2510. This bill still has the same flaws as it did when introduced during previous sessions.

- It places overreaching, unnecessary requirements on legal firearm owners.
 It does nothing to actually address those that cannot legally own a firearm.
 It contains an emergency clause. If sponsors felt that the bill had true overwhelming public support, citizens would be allowed to put it to a vote if the bill passes. In addition, I fail to see how a bill that was introduced years earlier should still receive an emergency clause.

I urge you to not pass this out of committee.
