We also have many stores that are interested on selling our product located in southern Oregon and unfortunately we cannot get our extracts into these stores due to the logistical nightmare of the wholesale being 4 and 1/2 hours away, sadly, this affects directly our sells. deliveries and just order delivers are way to much time and energy for it to be worth it. Storing my own extracts at my facility would help us out a lot on all sides of the spectrum, and we respectfully ask you to please support SB 408.
