More specifics- The defendant may request a continuance without an attorney present and without the documentation of a motion, for the sole purpose of their right to consult with an attorney before proceeding any further with the judge assigned to the case. Don't know about delineating all the population count, either the court has 3 or more 'elected' or assigned judges presiding in the county of the State Circuit or county does not. ORS 14.270 doesn't mean anything, but a hill of beans if an individual brings an action against the court for unequal treatment under the law by being denied the rights as every other person in this state is entitled to. Whoops, sorry judges, the Legislative Assembly just made your bench duties more complicated. Not used 'for the delay'; clause is threatening, if a person is not represented they should have every right to delay, no matter what the reason.
