Dear Chairman Dembrow,

I strongly oppose SB 223 and ask you to join with me by voting no on SB 223.

This bill is a significant threat to religious freedom and parental choice. SB 223 would essentially force private schools to register with the state or cut off student access to choir, sports, and other interscholastic programs.
