Chair Prusak, Vice Chairs Hayden and Salinas, and Members of the Committee,

My name is Kat Stone. I am a resident of Douglas County. I wish to express my opposition to HB2510 as currently written.

As regards the Safe Storage Bill, HB 2510, I believe that it requires modification

. Strict liability.

This component seems to cast firearms ownership as so inherently dangerous as to warrant onerous regulations.

• No definition set for adequate safes and locking devices.

As a health professional and a Democrat gun owner, I am concerned that OHA is being given too expansive authority to decide what constitutes an "adequate" locking or storage device.

I want the bill to more extensively define the guidelines OHA is expected to follow.

• Law Enforcement Officer exemption.

Per lines 40-42 of page [3] of the bill:

civilians would be held to a minimum standard of firearm storage from which police are exempt.

I believe that law enforcement should follow the same laws as Oregon citizens.

In conclusion, I ask that the Legislature consider modifying HB 2510 to address the above points before putting it to the floor.
