This year Oregon has multiple legislative bills coming up which offer new and better choices for election procedures. However, SB 791 exclusively promotes Ranked Choice Voting (RCV), which has proved to be unpopular with voters in many states where it has been introduced then quickly repealed. A better choice is Star Voting, a concept first developed in Oregon by Mark Frohnmayer. It is a more expressive, more fair, and easier to understand method which does not require the replacement of our state voting machines. I urge you to reject SB 791 and instead support HB 3250 STAR Voting for Oregon bill introduced by Rep. Zach Hudson, which should reach the Senate later this session.
