I'm asking you to support this Bill. From 2011 until 2014, I was a municipal housing inspector in the Minneapolis Metro region and enforced housing law. I was not a licensed law enforcement officer, I carried no gun, but I could write citations and represent the city in court.

My only tool for gathering evidence? A camera. With nothing more than a picture I had the ability to cite property owners for violations and represent the city in court. There is no reason for a licensed law officer to be required to review and issue citation based on photographic evidence. Police budgets are already under huge constraints and at a time when officers are needed to address real crimes against communities, ticketing speeders does not need to be an additional task or constraint for staff time.
