I SUPPORT HB3239 Establishes where Cannabis/Hemp may be chemically processed

I want to thank the sponsors of HB3239 for presenting this bill and for the committee for offering a public hearing and a work study session. I support HB3239 that requires all marijuana and hemp butane and ethanol or other chemical extraction processing to be located in industrial zones only and not within 2,000 feet of any areas zoned for rural residential uses.

I have lived next to a marijuana extraction processing site and it has all but destroyed my quality of life, with bully behaviors, increased traffic, horrific odors that have permeated my own property and the daily fear of explosive fires.
