I have been living in Oregon for the past 13 years, and very soon become involved with local wildlife and nature groups. One of the things that amazed the most, was after visiting the beautiful eastern Oregon, reading a few books about the land, and it's most prominent animal - the beaver.

The mass slaughter hunting that this species suffered and still sustains, is nothing short of an environmental disaster, and laws and regulations promoting and protecting their existing would bring innumerous benefits. Farmers and land owners need to be educated and learn how beneficial it will be to everyone if let to do its natural thing. This is about work together to preserve the better future of our lands, and I strongly favor any laws promoting the beaver habitat and its survival in coexistence with land owners - it is possible and beneficial for all people and other wildlife.
