Dear Representative Paul Holvey, and members of the Business and Labor House 2021, Regular Session,

I would like to present my support for HB 3130. As a substitute teacher for over 10 years and a full time teacher for one, I was very disappointed when I found out all of the school districts in my area have outsourced their substitute teacher services. To be a substitute teacher in Oregon one must have a teaching license. Some substitutes may have a limited substitute license, but most are fully credentialed teachers. I have ten years in Oregon PERS and an IAP. Now, as a substitute teacher, I can no longer accrue years of service in PERS or contribute to my IAP when I am working in the schools and providing a continuity of education for our children in the absence of the regular teacher. I strongly encourage you to support this bill, or at least provide a way for substitute teachers to contribute to their IAP while providing the vital service of substitute teaching.
