The Covid pandemic has decimated small businesses that are truly the fabric of our communities. Precious little was given to support our local businesses and especially our local cultural venues - movie houses, stage theaters, dance and music venues. Most all were COMPLETELY shut down for months on end. The rent, utilities, insurance, taxes didn't shut down however.
