Title: SB 92, OTIS: Confidentiality of Child Abuse Records

Concept:

ORS 419B.035 will be amended to extend the existing child abuse reports and records protections to reports and records compiled under ORS 418.257 to 418.259.

Need for policy change:

The Office of Training Investigations and Safety (OTIS) of the Oregon Department of Human Services (ODHS) is responsible for conducting child abuse investigations within Child-Caring Agencies (CCAs). SB 1515 (2016) provided young adults, ages 18 to 20 placed in CCAs with the same abuse protections as other children and defined a "child in care" to include certain young adults under 21 years of age.

Unfortunately, it did not mirror the confidentiality of record protections that exist for other child abuse investigations. Senate Bill (SB) 92 seeks to compliment SB 1515 (2016) by extending the same confidentiality protections provided by ORS 419B.035 to these investigations.
