This bill will cost jobs. I do not feel that the legislature understands just how expensive Oregon is to farm in already, people will just stop raising crops that require any labor. If this bill were passed on a national scale it would be different, but being just Oregon, with Covid still causing so much uncertainty, during a drought, this is horrible timing.
