

VOTE YES SB766

SEXUAL ABUSE PROTECTIVE ORDER (SAPO)

SB766 IS A TECHNICAL FIX TO OREGON'S SEXUAL ABUSE PROTECTIVE ORDER (SAPO). THE FIX WILL ADDRESS TWO CRITICAL ISSUES TO PROMOTE SURVIVOR PRIVACY AND SAFETY.

SB766 WILL REMOVE:

1) THE CURRENT RISK OF RELEASING PERSONALLY IDENTIFYING INFORMATION OF MINORS (DATE OF BIRTH), A PRIVACY ISSUE AND VIOLATION OF FEDERAL LAW.

2) CURRENT PROCEDURES THAT MAY PUBLICLY RELEASE THE SURVIVOR'S ASSAULT HISTORY WHEN SERVICE ON RESPONDENT OF SEXUAL ABUSE PROTECTIVE ORDER IS COMPLETED BY AN ALTERNATIVE METHOD.

SAPOS ARE CRITICAL TO SURVIVORS WHO ARE NOT OTHERWISE ELIGIBLE FOR AN ORDER OF PROTECTION, BUT WHO NEED ACCESS TO SAFETY MEASURES.

SAPOS REMOVE BARRIERS TO PROTECTION AND ENSURE THAT VICTIMS OF SEXUAL VIOLENCE ARE PROVIDED THE SAFETY THEY NEED IN THE AFTERMATH OF AN ASSAULT.
