I was diagnosed with type 1 diabetes during my first year of college. Because my body cannot produce insulin on its own, I depend on taking insulin every day to stay alive and healthy. Without it, I would become life-threateningly ill and would need to be hospitalized. Worse, I could die.

For many Oregonians living with diabetes, access to insulin is a matter of life or death. No one should have to ration their insulin because they cannot afford it. No one should have to decide between paying for their life-sustaining medication or paying for that month's rent or food. No one should have to compromise their health or lose their life because they cannot afford the insulin they need to survive.

Oregon has an opportunity to take a step in the right direction and make insulin more affordable. I urge you to vote in favor of HB 2623.
