My name is Kristen and I live in Multnomah County. I am writing in support of SB 583.

There are many concerns with mega-dairys. It particularly concerns me that cows in mega-dairies typically live their entire life indoors in huge buildings, only moving between tiny stalls and milking parlors until they are eventually killed because they are "unproductive." In mega-dairies, cows often stand on hard concrete, which leads to foot damage and exacerbates lameness. And being intensely confined on a large scale means massive amounts of antibiotics - which can be passed along to humans - are required to treat common diseases in confined cattle, like mastitis.

There are many other concerns with mega-dairys, such as their impact on water, climate and farmers. Please support SB 583. We need to protect our people, our animals and our planet.
