I am writing in reference to SB 191. I am currently incarcerated at CCCF. I have served 15 1/2 yrs of a 22 1/2 yr Measure 11 sentence. I've been free of all discipline reports the entire time I've been incarcerated. My being able to have good time coupled with it being retroactive would mean so much to my family and to myself. It would reduce my sentence by 4 yrs 5 months. I'd be released in 2 yrs 7 months. This would be a godsend to my husband who is in poor health. He needs me home. My elderly parents (ages 90+89 respectfully) would be relieved to have me out of prison early. They worry constantly. Being released early under retroactive good time would enable me to become a productive citizen early. I'd be able to get a job. If released in 7 yrs, my age at that time would make it very hard to get hired.

I pray that you allow SB 191 to include retroactive good time.
