I wish to record my fervent opposition to SB 832. Without any comment or consideration on the actual subject matter of the bill, the underlying premise of a public taking without just compensation is simply untenable, frightening, and completely contrary to both statutory and case law on this matter. Armstrong v. United States; Kelo v. New London, and others, provide a breadth of case law that, should this legislation be litigated, provide strong legal grounds for its reversal or amendment.

I urge the Committee to amend the legislation as it presently reads to add much-needed language to ensure the just compensation of those who stand to be aggrieved by this legislation.
