<u>SB 191</u> - I support this Bill for equal rights for Adults in Custody with Measure 11 convictions - to have the same equal opportunities as others in custody - to earn a reduction in their time for good behavior.

I believe given incentives to work at the prison, to take classes to better themselves - perhaps earning a degree, will give them hope to be able to shorten their sentences and get back home with spouses and children - parents.

Changes in attitude and behavior can certainly be a positive when given hope for a future.

I'm not suggesting that there should not be consequences for actions...but I believe we all deserve a second chance to change our lives and I also believe that change is possible!!
