I am writing in strong support of SB 684. Justice that pits an individual practitioners resources, which have frequently been decimated by a board while years of legal wrangling occurs, against a state boards resources is no justice at all. Too, a board made up almost solely of the profession which they are sanctioning has a multitude of reasons for targeting professionals which do not include professional misconduct.
