Also, if ever (and it isn't right now) chemical recycling is a viable option, recycling centers need the expertise and facilities to deal with current and future developments. We are way behind the demand at present. Since we use so much plastic, (take a look in your refrigerators, pantries, etc.) we need the facilities to handle the load well. More trained staff, advanced equipment, and streamlined processing are a must. Let's do this for our children and grandchildren, for ourselves, and for our planet.
