I am writing on behalf of my sister. Who has been in jail for the last 20 years. She was sentenced to serving 25 years without the chance of parole. She was not given the option to have the chance of being released early with good behavior because of Measure 11. I believe that over the last 20 years she has shown enough good behavior, changing her life around to the best that she can being in jail, she should be able to have the opportunity to share that and be able to get out sooner. But measure 11 prevents that!

The crime does not fit the time! Her crime does not fit the total amount of time that she has already served. Again, measure 11 has prevented her to be able to get out! measure 11 has also made it were to she does not get the opportunity among many others to show their good time and to show their good behavior that they have done to be able to get released early. That is a point of jail, not locking somebody up for their entire life for crime that doesn't make them dangerous to society, jail is for learning their lesson, to change their lives around. My sister has definitely learned her lesson, she has also definitely changed her life around.
