I submitted testimony earlier, but I have a specific example of why this bill is needed.

I bought some blueberries that came in a plastic box with a "1" inside the chasing arrows triangle. It also said, "100% recyclable plastic, made with 100% renewable energy and recycled bottles. # We care." This is false labeling. Number 1 rigid plastic containers are not recyclable in Oregon—even if I were to take them to a depot.

Please make sure that SB 582 prohibits the triangle on plastic containers. They mislead consumers into thinking that they are recyclable.
