Dear Chair Golden, and Members of the Committee on Natural Resources and Wildfire Response,

I am writing as the Chair Emeritus of The Nature Conservancy's Oregon Board of Trustees and as a former member of the Governor's Council on Wildfire Response. The comprehensive legislation within SB 762 would take urgent, proactive steps to support healthy, resilient ecosystems and livable communities for generations to come.
