Please support HB2742, as it corrects strange restrictions in licensee privileges. Currently, only Limited On-Premise licensees (aka "Tavern Licenses") can sell containers holding more than 7 gallons for use specifically off-premise. Off-Premise licensees (retailers selling beer, wine and cider) are unable to offer these sizes, for off-premise consumption. Seems backwards. My stores receive regular requests for keg sales, and I have to explain where they can purchase. Passing HB2742 will increase convenience for Oregon consumers. Thanks for your consideration.
