Thank you for your consideration. If monies go to OSU, or to Agriculture/small business grants, please consider the following. Fiber from hemp and wood and fiber from bamboo can be used to substitute for paper products to replace plastic packaging. They can be used for clothing, which would then detour the spread in our water of plastic (polyester) microfibers. Hemp with lime, can now be used to produce building products, and of course bamboo makes excellent wood floors. These products...plus the many others that are possible, would need processing, and molding, spinning, etc. plus all the associated manufacturing and marketing peoplepower. This would mean JOBS.
