Equipment and weapons Portland and other police departments in Oregon have been reported using to attack protesters against police brutality:

(a) FN303 rifles firing plastic bullets often filled with OC powder and other chemical weaponry

(b) "Less lethal" launchers firing CS gas, OC gas, pepper spray, mace, and other chemical weapons

(c) foam tipped impact munitions

Many of these weapons and munitions used against citizens exercising their First Amendment rights are NOT military equipment surplus

Military equipment surplus there have been no reports of police in Oregon using to attack protesters against police brutality: (a) Unmanned aircraft systems that are armored or weaponized;

(b) Aircraft that are combat-configured or combat-coded;

(c) Grenades or similar explosives, or grenade launchers (unless you specifically include/are referring to flash bangs, stinger grenades, and "less lethal" launchers used to fire chemical weapons);

(d) Firearms silencers; or

(e) Mine-resistant vehicles,

House Bill 2481 is nothing but performative legislation -- intended to look good on paper without preventing a single injury or upsetting a single cop.
