I live just outside Oregon City, Oregon. Oregon City is part of the Portland Metro Area. TriMet is the Portland Metro light rail service that encompasses only about 2/3 of the Portland Metro Area. If the light rail continued south to Oregon City and then to Clackamas Town Center, then the circuit would be completed. There could then be "spurs" of other smaller light rail, street car, or electric buses to connect community areas such as other town centers, community colleges, etc. to the main TriMet light rail circuit.

The light rail system would be utilized much better, by people, if it were better interconnected and made a complete circuit. Also, if the Energy Innovation And Carbon Dividend Act were passed, it would also create more motivation for people to use the light rail to cut down on CO2 emissions.
