Latino Network is an active and engaged partner in addressing the needs of Latinx youth and families in east county and Gresham. Currently Latino Network is serving 1252 participants in the Gresham/Rockwood area. Longstanding systemic barriers coupled with the impacts of the COVID-19 pandemic have disproportionately and negatively affected the physical, social, and economic wellbeing of our youth, families and community. Propelled by these difficult realities, and with added urgency as the incidence of community violence rises, we must act now.
