The notion that someone in possession of a legally concealed handgun ought to be made a criminal for carrying on about their daily lives is absurd.

Anyone who has completed the legal coursework required to carry a concealed handgun in the great state of Oregon, and been issued their permit following the Sheriff's background check, fingerprinting, photograph, and other licensing requirements, ought not to be considered acting in bad faith, and that's entirely what this bill presumes. This bill and the amendments to this bill don't do any favors to anyone trying to make sense of what is already a complex legal landscape, and as opposed to curtailing criminality as (presumably) intended, will simply manufacture criminals out of ordinary citizens.
