Caregiving is in my belief the most important type of work for humanity -- as a society is only judged on how it takes care of it's most vulnerable. Personally, I was able to find the same kind of work closer to my home and I live in Salem, but I am driving an hour to see my client. I have already built a strong relationship for nurturing this person. That's a testament to this line of work. The population of retirees is growing, I believe caregiving to become a more valuable asset to society. Paying direct support professional caregivers a livable wage builds a strong and robust community. It is our best path forward.
