The bills complement each other and are both vital to the future of Oregon.

The training element included in HB2387 will be invaluable for all of Oregon but especially for those regions of the state where distance is an issue.

The funding in HB2738 is critical to this program. We wish it were more. It is inconceivable that CASA's are forced to fundraise for so much of their support. I checked on the Polk County CASA website. They were selling Christmas trees this fall for fundraising and had to cancel their other two events due to COVID-19. I believe in the past they also sold poinsettia.

Oregon can and should do better for our volunteers who are so important to those children placed in foster care.
