I respectively reject The Governor's reduction packages 090 and 092. The Mid coast water planning partnership is a science-based partnership hinging on the involvement of ODWR, ODFW, and DEQ. The data collected and the studies that have been performed in the past and present are essential to our decision-making process. These agencies are understaffed and under funded.

I ask you to Please support ODFW policy option package 114. We need ODFW at the partnership table! Please support, ODFW POP 115 and OWRD POP 113, Please support POP 105 for ODFW, OWRD, and DEQ, POP OWRD 110, OWRD POP 109

The fact of the matter is that most of our mid coast streams and rivers are on the 303-d list of impaired waters. The low flows, high water temps, and low DO is deadly to the aquatic life.
