As the Director of the Josephine County Fairgrounds, I'd like to say that we have been significantly impacted by horse racing in a positive way. Not only has horse racing been a part of our County's Fairgrounds history, with the recent formation of Grants Pass Downs, horse racing is also a part of our Fairgrounds future. The lease of Fairgrounds property provides nearly \$300,000 annually of much needed revenue to the Fairgrounds. In addition, we've seen improvements of the racetrack and supporting facilities improving the overall functionality of these areas and aesthetic to the community.
