In rural natural resource economies like ours, we are focused on equipping our students with the skills they need to succeed as early as possible. Many of our students go on to become commercial fishermen, or join the Coast Guard. The critical skills they learn through our partnership with the renewed Greater Toledo Aquatic and Community Center will set the foundation for them to contribute meaningfully, and safely, to Oregon's economy.
