Professional Energy Kinesiology Practitioners should not be included in Bill HB 2493. Since 1989, the International Association of Specialized Kinesiologists and later, in 1993, the Energy Kinesiology Association (of the United States) has proudly, and with much forethought, granted practitioner certification to individuals who exhibit the professionalism, discipline, and dedication required to meet the established criteria to be a Professional Energy Kinesiology Practitioner. The requirements are strict and well-thought-out and are designed to assess knowledge and skill in the practitioner. The organization requires significant Ethics training, specific to the profession as a requirement for certification. The levels of Energy Kinesiology certification are recognized in Energy Medicine as a significant professional accomplishment.
