(1) In addition to and not in lieu of any other appropriation, there is appropriated to the Housing and Community Services Department, for the biennium beginning July 1, 2021, out of the General Fund: (a) \$2,000,000 for awarding and administering grants under section 2 of this 2021 Act; and (b) \$2,000,000 for distribution to community action agencies with the advice of the Community Action Partnership of Oregon to provide loans, grants or other financial assistance to income-eligible households for the repair and rehabilitation of their residences as described in section 2 of this 2021 Act and for administering the distribution of moneys under this paragraph."

There are additional atrocities included in [SB 276] but, I do not want to spoil the excitement of "self-discovery."
