

SB 36: Commercial Feeds Fee Increase

Purpose: Senate Bill 36 proposes to increase the statutory cap to register livestock feeds and the feeds manufacturer license.

Background

ODA registers and inspects commercial feed products and manufactures of livestock feed in Oregon. The registration encompasses records, formulation labels, market batch testing for quality, and maintaining a database for product recalls.

The commercial feed program is fully sustained by registration and manufacturer fees. To maintain the current service level in this program, a fee increase is necessary. Without a fee increase, the program is projected to fall below the minimum amount required to sustain the current level of services by the end of the 2021-23 biennium. SB 36 will allow ODA to adjust the fees administratively to cover the cost of administering the program.

Statutory Changes

SB 36 amends ORS 633.015 to increase the statutory feeds registration cap from \$20 to \$60 per formulation and amends ORS 633.029 to increase the statutory feeds manufacturer license cap from \$500 to \$1,000 per manufacture.
