

I oppose the move of any processing from ODA to OLCC due to the fact that hemp is a legal agricultural commodity as defined by the 2018 Farm Bill. I support a broader conversation with all stakeholders on the future of hemp regulations in Oregon, I know that HB 2281 has been worked on for multiple sessions with stakeholder and agency engagement.

HB 3000 was rushed through without collaboration or transparency and as it is written HB 3000 will kill Oregon's legal hemp industry.
