I am both an actor and acting coach and am someone of ethnicity. I have been in the industry for over 30 years (Over 20 in LA) and am fortunate to have worked with an incredible array of talent. That said - what has been disappointing and frustrating has been the lack of diversity and representation in the industry. I was extremely fortunate to be chosen to be one of the teachers for the Talent Diversity program initiated by Cast Iron Studios - a 36-hour intensive acting course gave 32 performers of color the opportunity to hone their chops with Portland's finest acting coaches and a myriad of guest speakers, at no cost to the actors. That experience was life changing. I heard from artists of all backgrounds what it feels like to be underrepresented and stereotyped. What I know is that there is an abundance of talent that is not given the opportunity to be a part of this industry. What I know is that this lack of representation results in one noted stereotypes. The impact of the lack of representation has a deep negative effect on artists. I speak from personal experience. The bottom line - Diversity, Equity and Inclusion must be a priority within the industry.

Please **vote YES on HB 3010** to encourage diversity, equity, and inclusion in our local production industry. I look forward to witnessing the change that comes about when this bill passes!
