## **OACCD Supports Senate Bill 620**

The Oregon Association of Community Corrections Directors (OACCD) supports Senate Bill 620. This bill proposes to change the current statute language from "shall" to "may" with regard to the local decision to charge Justice Involved Individuals (JII) monthly supervision fees. OACCD is in support of the overall goal to move away from the practice of imposing fees of supervision to JII. However, based on current funding level of the Community Corrections budget, we also recognize the need for most jurisdictions state-wide to depend on this income source to support the sanctions, services and programs available to serve our JII population. We do believe this is a good direction to move and an aspirational goal for community corrections moving forward.
