

House Bill 2543. This Bill removes an important failsafe and protection of a fundamental right during the background check process that will create an indefinite delay during a firearm purchase. This would give the government unlimited discretion to prevent someone from exercising their Second Amendment rights. In addition, the bill does not address the real issue, staffing the state mandated background check system.

This bill intentionally lacks a upper limit on when a background check must not be delayed by which by all practical proposes suspenses/cancels out a fundamental Constitutional Right which is the real purpose behind this bill
