To whom it may concern:

If I am reading this proposed change to our rules and regulations. A private security officer in possession of a firearm would be detained and arrested for having his side arm. A privately contracted monetary transport company driving past a hospital would be eligible for felony charges for simply going to work and following the route they were given by their dispatcher.

It is quite convenient for us to change laws and rules with a grand sense of justice and right. However when we write laws that have a blanket effect on the population we must consider all the possible fallout from them. This was poorly written and is poorly thought out. I have a right to bear arms. If I am walking down the street next to the court house my right to bear arms has not changed.

I have no issue with the rules regarding restrictions of weapons inside of City, State and Federal Government buildings. I find it perfectly reasonable for the officers of the law to be in possession of the only weapons inside of these places. I however should not have to go out of my way to walk around an entire city block just to avoid the sidewalk of a parking lot for a court house.

This law would put undue duress on many people. It would make felons of people who have committed no crime before. It over steps my constitutional right to bear arms.

You ask to much, this is clearly an overstep.
