Allowing convicted felons to have the right to vote while incarcerated removes one the fundamental punishments for breaking the law in America. The right to vote is sacred and should be held at the highest value. Allowing incarcerated criminals this right decreases the value of the right to vote. The right to vote should only be granted to those that are legal American citizens who uphold and respect the laws of Oregon and of America. It is despicable that such a measure is even on the table for consideration. We must demand our laws be obeyed, enforced and PUNISHED or we will have nothing left to preserve. The actions of abandonment from law and order, punishment, the Constitution, and basic American values are not acceptable.
