OFRI provide a great deal of support for k-12 students. OFRI provides funding for the Talk About Trees (TAT) program that reaches over 100,000 Oregon school children each year. The TAT programs provides science based, hands-on lessons free of charge to schools across the state of Oregon. OFRI also provides bus funding for forest related files trips. Additionally, OFRI funds ONREP. ONREP provides free teacher workshops. To defund OFRI would deprive Oregon school children and teachers of a valuable educational resource. Thank you.
